










### Rules and Printing Indications

#### How to use this resource

Basic Rules of Memory

- Shuffle all the cards.
- Lay them face down in rows.
- The first player chooses 2 cards to reveal. If they match he keeps them and can play again.
- If they do not match, he puts them back face down. The next player proceeds the same way.
- The game is over when there is no card left.
- The player who found the most pairs is the winner.

#### How to print and prepare this resource

It takes time to prepare a set of cards. I would say about an hour, from start to finish.

Step 1: Cut a piece of cardboard. I cut mine 6cm x 4.5cm (that's about 2.4 x 1.8) and it works fine for me. You might need to adjust your dimensions though.





<u>Step 2:</u> Print the pages you need for your game. Stick the pieces of cardboard at the back of each card and laminate.
