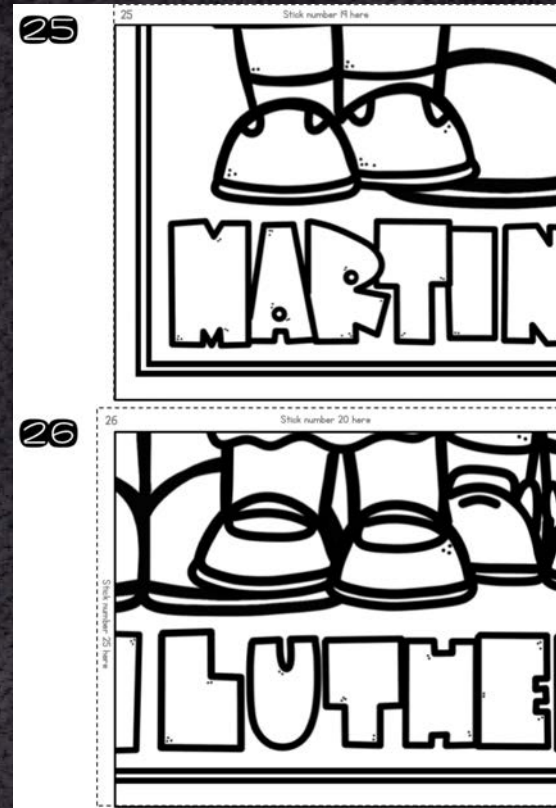

Martin Luther King was born in Atlanta, Georgia on January 15th 1929. He was a civil rights activist and leader. He led non-violent protests and fought for equal rights of all people.

He led the Montgomery Bus Boycott after Rosa Parks was arrested and sent to jail. The boycott lasted for a year and at then end, segregation on the Montgomery buses ended.

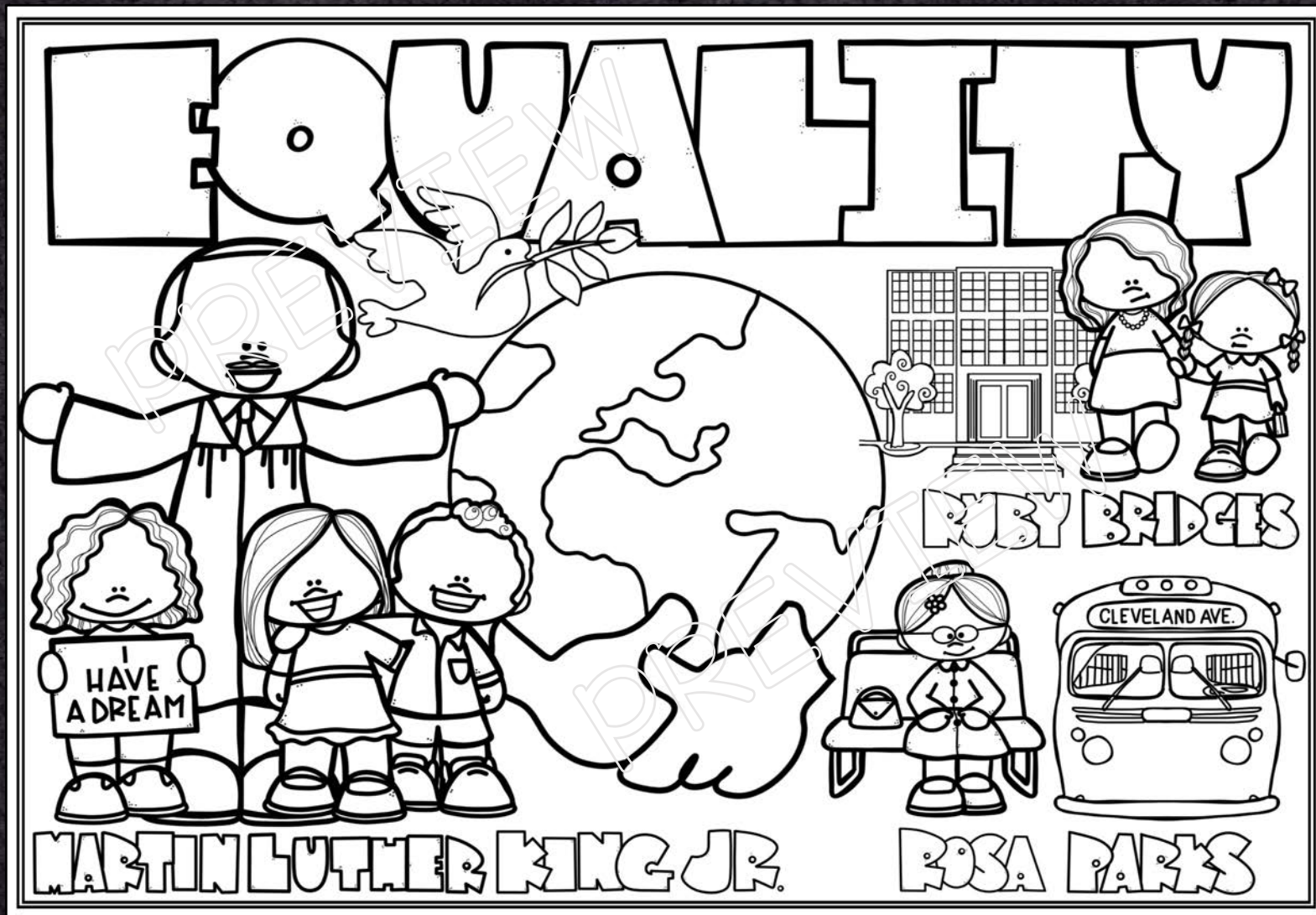
In 1963, MLK delivered his famous "I have a Dream" speech. He won the Nobel Peace Prize in 1964
