

A family tree !

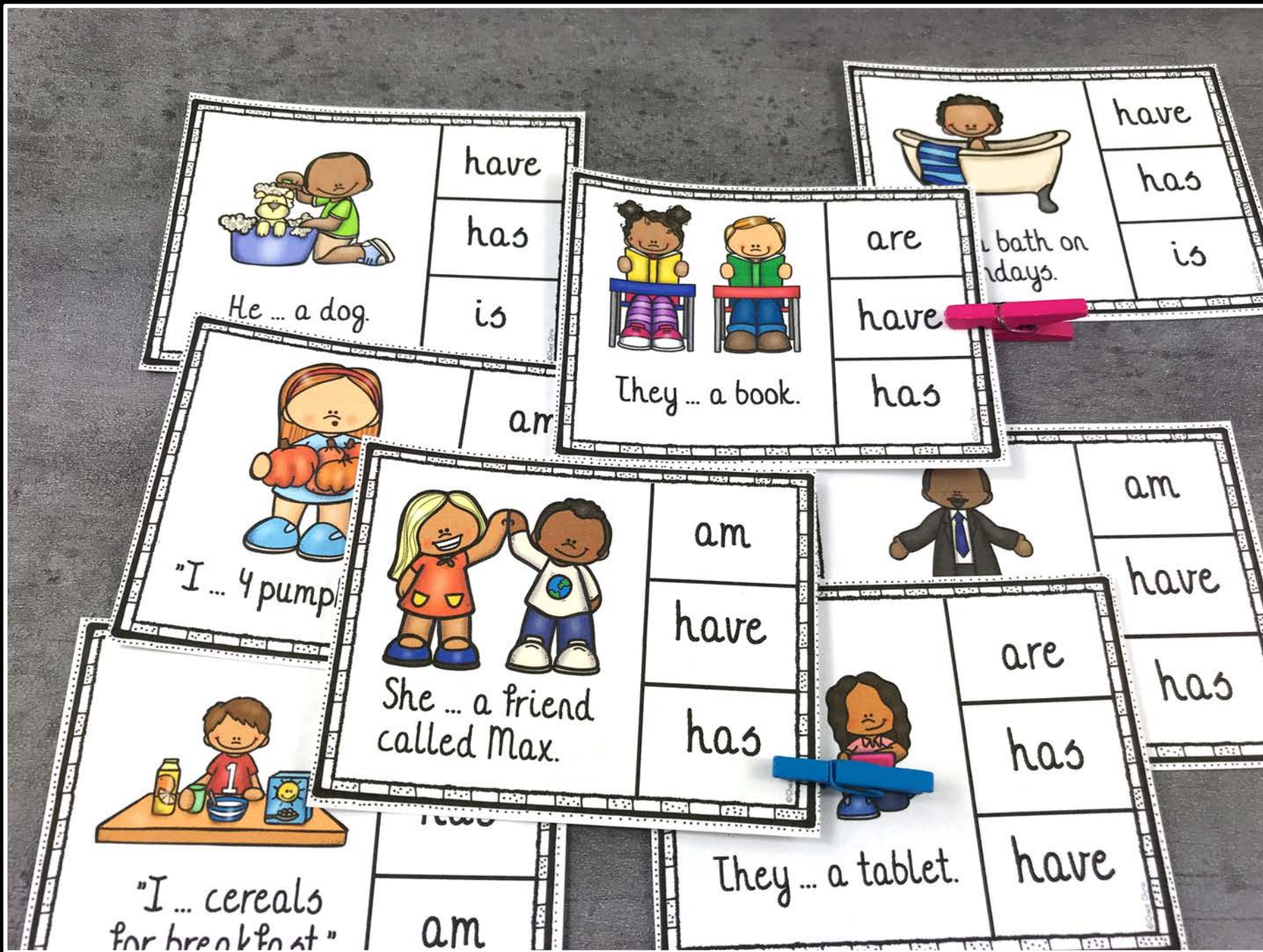
Write the names of the people in this family tree

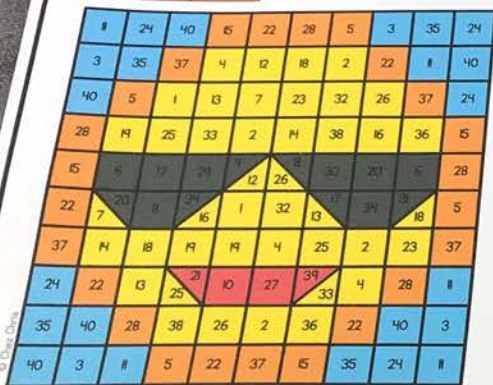

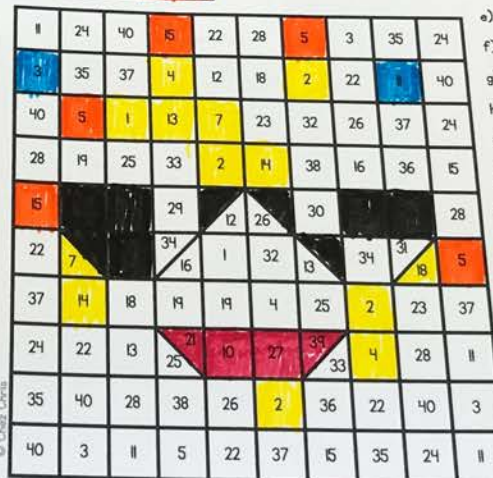

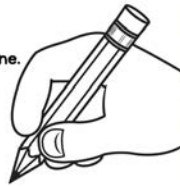
