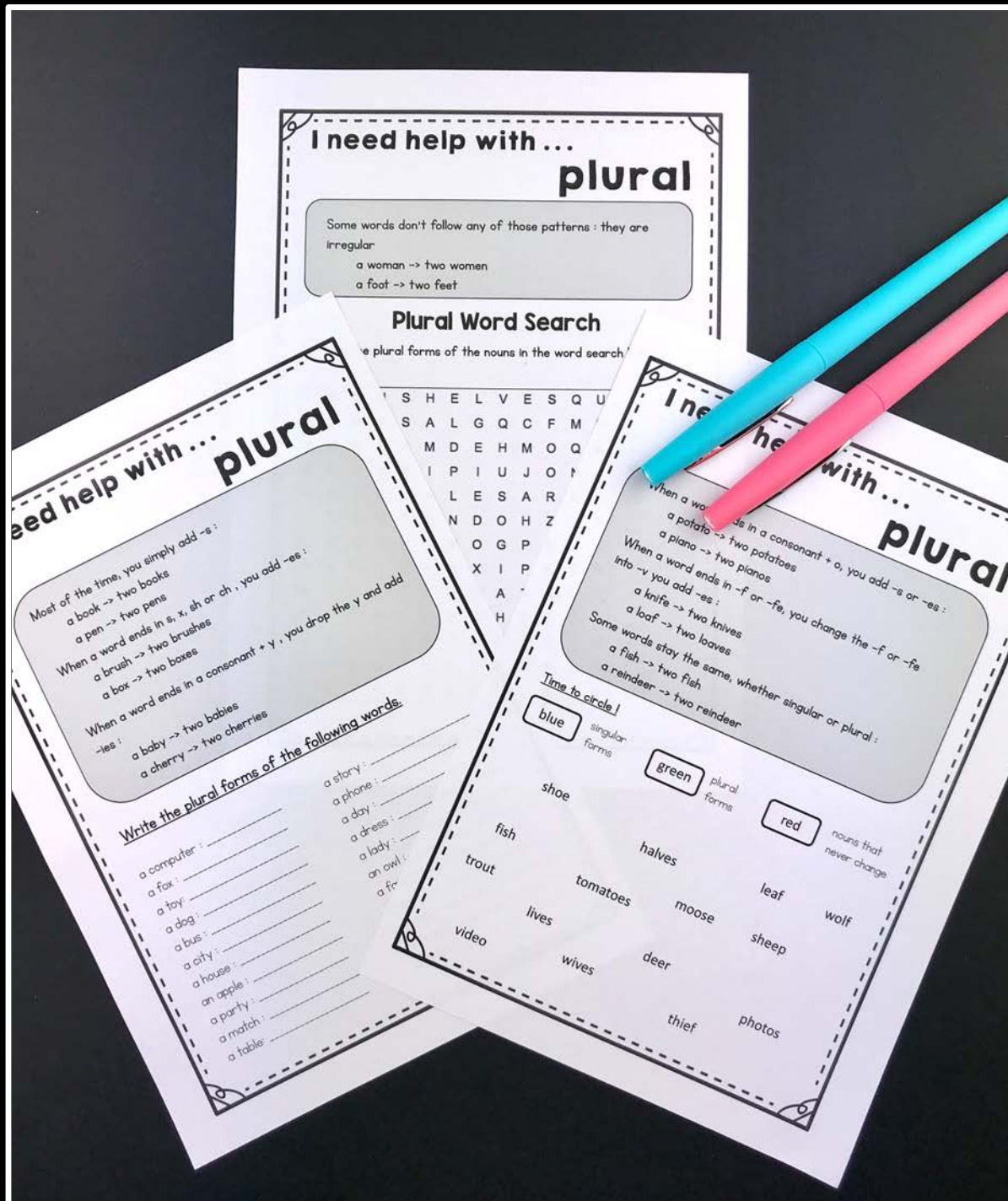

When a word ends in a consonant + o, you add -s :

a potato -> two potatoes

a piano -> two pianos

When a word ends in -f or -fe, you change the -f into -v you add -es :

a knife -> two knives

a loaf -> two loaves

Some words stay the same, whether singular or plural :

a fish -> two fish

a reindeer -> two reindeer
